The project SIPLA NORD- promoted by Consorzio Communitas and co-financed by the Ministry of Interior with the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund 2014-20 (FAMI) and the Authority delegated of the Ministry of Labour and social policies- is a national network of garrisons and territorial services created to protect and support foreign and non-community employees in agriculture against forms of illegal hiring and exploitation. The regions involved in the project are Emilia Romagna, Friuli Venezia Giulia, Lazio, Liguria, Lombardia, Marche, Piemonte, Toscana and Trentino Alto-Adige.

## THE PROJECT CONSISTS OF:

- Health care interventions to prevent extremely risky situations for the health and safety of the employees;
- Activation of information services and protection aimed at promoting legality and safety in work conditions;
- Agreements among stakeholders of the involved areas to implement concrete actions in work relationships, as a guarantee of legality, health conditions and safety conditions in work places;
- Specific training courses aimed at start-up businesses in the social agriculture sector.

## WHY DID THE SIPLA PROJECT ARISE? THE EXPERIENCE OF THE PROJECT "PRESIDIO DI CARITAS"

**SIPLA** arises from the experience of a previous project called "Presidio della Caritas italiana", which has supported more than 5,000 workers victims of exploitation in agriculture since 2014.

Afterwards, a collaboration between Consorzio Communitas and Arci Nazionale started and the SIPLA project emerged, divided into two territorial lots: Sipla Nord, which involves 9 regions in the central and northern area of Italy and Sipla Sud, including 6 regions in the central and southern area.

The network S.I.P.L.A has the purpose of building an integrated national system which can work on various levels: on a national level through advocacy actions and promotion of agreements and protocols with companies and the big distribution and on a local level through the construction of integrated interventions on a regional and multiregional level.

The partnership SIPLA NORD was constructed by taking into consideration the supply chain characterizing the agricultural system. SIPLA NORD both wants to find new solutions-and to support the ones that have already been started- different from slums and illegal employment and to promote transparency in supply-chain relationships.
